3	Professional discussion underpinned by portfolio	This assessment will take the form of a professional discussion which must be appropriately structured to draw out the best of the apprentice's competence and excellence and cover the KSBs assigned to this assessment method. The independent assessors will conduct and assess the professional discussion.	90 minutes
