Main purpose of the job

The successful candidate will join our new Sport and Exercise Science subject team subject team within the School of Human and Social Sciences, providing high-quality teaching and student experience and enhancing our research community. They will actively contribute to the School's research, enterprise and external engagement activities, and maintaining a portfolio of publication and income generation commensurate with the seniority of the post. They will also contribute to other activities within the School including student recruitment and taking on leadership roles and supporting junior colleagues. We are particularly interested in individuals with expertise in Biomechanics and / or Physiology and boarder experience leading on British Association of Sport and Exercise Science (BASES) and the Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity (CIMPSA) endorsed courses.
